David Leatherbarrow is an architect, writer and professor at PennDesign, University of Pennsylvania. He is one of the most productive and vivid theoreticians within the academic field of architecture of today. Ali Malkawi is an architect, Professor at Harvard Graduate School of Design, and Founding Director of the Harvard Center for Green Buildings and Cities. He is an international scholar and expert in building simulation, energy conservation, and sustainability in buildings.
