Points for Admission Test and Interview and Final Point Score 2024

The Royal Danish Academy invited 40 applicants for the Crafts in Glass and Ceramics programme to participate in this year's admission test and interview. 36 applicants completed the admission test by handing in the required assignments and participating in the interview.

The Academy expects to offer approximately 16 study places for the Crafts programme.

Below you find the scores from the admission test and interview along with your final point score from online test and test in Copenhagen.

It is the Final Point Score that determines who will be offered a study place.
