

Distribution of Point Scores

Professional Bachelor of Crafts in Glass and Ceramics

Admission Test in Copenhagen 10th May 2026

By 15 March, the Royal Danish Academy received 160 applications for the Professional Bachelor of Crafts in Glass and Ceramics.
84 applicants participated in the online admission test.
36 applicants were invited for the admission test in Copenhagen. 35 applicants participated.

Study places:

The academy will offer 18 study places and 1 standby place in Crafts in Glass and Ceramics.

Points:

Our point scale is 1-10 with 10 as the highest score. Assessment is based on 7 criteria. The highest possible score is 70 and the lowest is 7. 7 is used only for faulty uploads. For instance, files that could not be opened, missing submissions and submissions with breach of anonymity.
