

Professional Bachelor of Crafts in Glass and Ceramics

Points for Home Assignments 2025

By 15 March, the Royal Danish Academy received 143 applications for the Professional Bachelor of Crafts in Glass and Ceramics. 78 applicants submitted assignments during the online test on 23 March.

39 applicants for Crafts in Glass and Ceramics with a score of 30 points or more are invited for the admission test, provided the requirements for qualifying exams are met. Please notice that all casework has not yet been completed.

Invited applicants will be notified and asked to confirm that they wish to participate. In our invitation will also be specified what to bring. As for information about transportation and more, please use our website.

The admission test and interview take place in Copenhagen on 4 May. Invited applicants will be notified individually.

Study places:

The academy will offer 16 study places in Crafts in Glass and Ceramics. And in addition, 1 standby place.

Points:

Our point scale is 1-10 with 10 as the highest score.

1 is used only for faulty uploads. For instance, files that could be opened, uploads with less than three files and uploads with breach of anonymity.
