By 15 March, the Royal Danish Academy received 160 applications for the Professional Bachelor of Crafts in Glass and Ceramics. 84 applicants submitted assignments during the online test.

36 applicants for Crafts in Glass and Ceramics with a score of 33 points or more are invited for the next stage of the admission process, provided that they meet requirements for qualifying exams. Please note that all casework has not yet been completed.

Invited applicants will be notified and asked to confirm that they wish to participate. The invitation will also specify what to bring. As for information about transportation and more, please use our website.

The admission test and interview take place in Copenhagen on 10 May. Invited applicants will be notified individually.

Study places:

The academy will offer 16 study places and 1 stand by place in Crafts in Glass and Ceramics.

Points:

Our point scale is 1-10 with 10 as the highest score. Assessment is based on 5 criteria. The highest possible score is 50 and the lowest is 5. 5 is used only for faulty uploads. For instance, files that could not be opened, uploads with less than three files and uploads with breach of anonymity.
